Season Review

The first goal of the 2019/2020 season was certainly to bring the Primavera back to the Primavera 1 championship after the relegation to Primavera 2 suffered in the previous season. In a very difficult sporting season, the first squad of the youth sector nevertheless hit the target four match days in advance thus meeting the club's expectations.

The sporting season ended with the suspension of all the youth championships in March and of the training activities at the Vismara Sports Center. Despite this stop, the Club remained close to its youth sector, with the staff very active digitally organizing daily video training, team calls and activities organized by the psycho-pedagogical area.

146 staff members, including 70 coaches and athletic trainers, 37 accompanying managers and 39 scouts. At the Vismara Sports Center, the main headquarter of the activities of the Youth Sector, there are 23 employees including the sporting and organizational secretariat, the video, IT, athletic and warehouse areas.

40 young players stayed at the Convitto "Fondazione Clerici" with 10 tutors.

Both Esordienti and Pulcini participated in many tournaments also at an international level.
